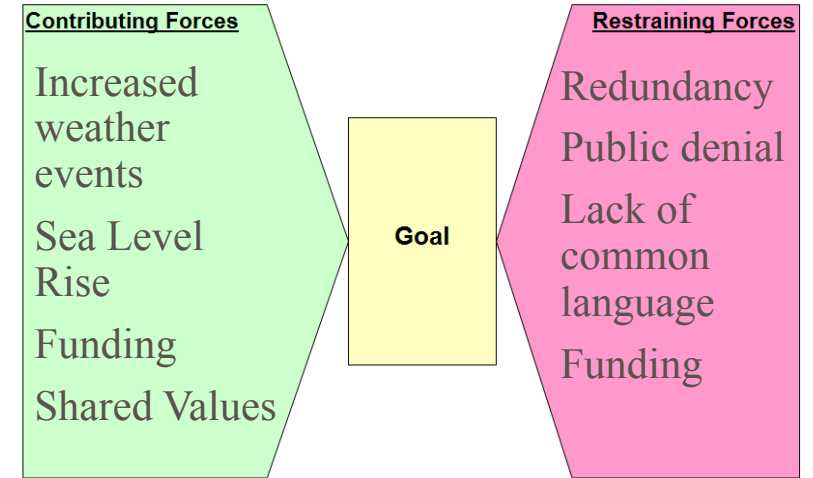

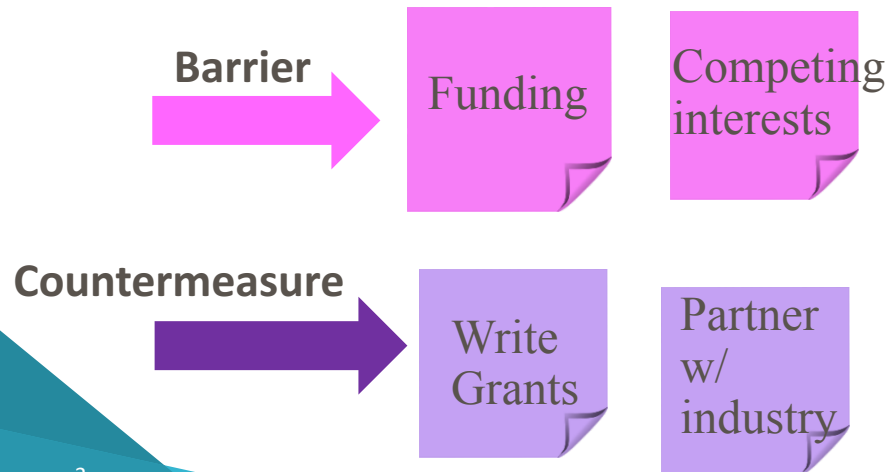

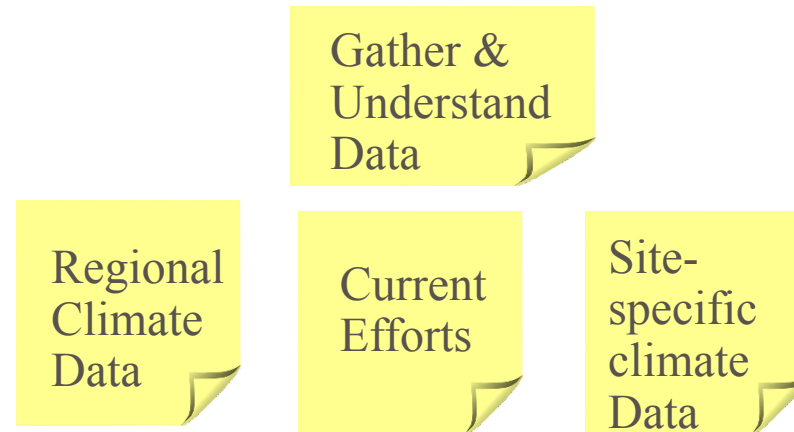
## 2. Identify opportunities and barriers for effective collaboration



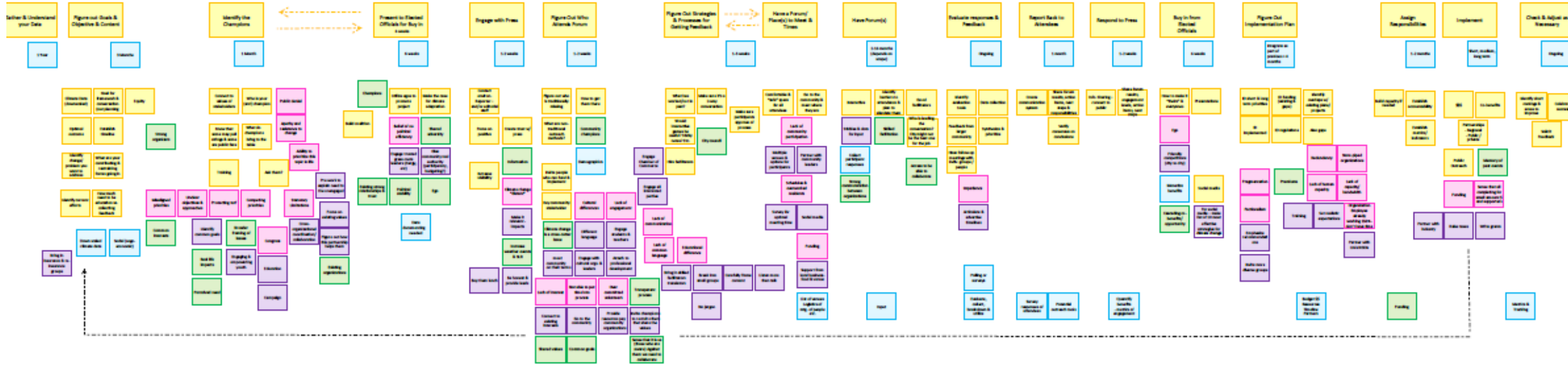
## 3. Brainstorm ideas to counter the barriers
